Matteo Colaninno was born in Mantua on 16 October 1970 and holds a degree in Business & Economics. He has been Deputy Chair of the Piaggio Group since 2004 and a director since 2003.

He is a member of the Italian Parliament and head of the Italia Viva group on the Chamber of Deputies' European Union Policies Commission.

He was first elected to the Chamber of Deputies in 2008 and re-elected in 2013 and 2018. He served as head of economic policy in the national secretariat of the PD (Partito Democratico, Democratic Party) and as PD shadow minister for Economic Growth.

Matteo Colaninno is Deputy Chair and CEO of Omniaholding and a director of Immsi and Omniainvest. He is a member of the management board of the Italy-India association to promote cooperation between the two countries.

He is a member of the advisory board of the Rome Biomedical Campus University Foundation.

From 2005 to 2008, Matteo Colaninno was national Chair of Confindustria Young Entrepreneurs, Deputy Chair of Confindustria and Deputy Chair of the European Confederation of Young Entrepreneurs.

From 2001 to 20 February 2008, he was Deputy Chair of Banca Popolare di Mantova.
